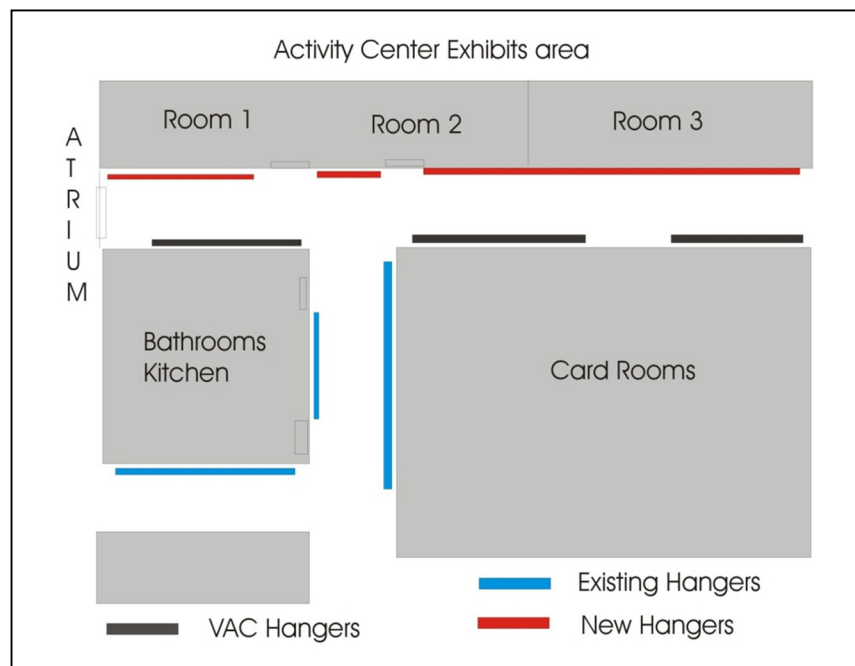


New Exhibit Area Expands Photography Club Exhibit Options

During the past month, we received CA permission to mount hanging rails in the Activity Center in the Hallways outside the meeting rooms. The rail, built and erected by Roy McDonald and Charles Byers, was constructed in the woodshop. It was completed late last week. It adds forty linear feet for exhibits in a heavily travelled area of the community. A diagram follows.

- Fresh Ideas are always welcome.
