

## Pickett Trail – Georgetown

At the west end of 8th street you will find Chautauqua Park, which borders on the South Fork of the San Gabriel River. The Pickett Trailhead is begins at a green wooden arch at the north side of the park. It continues along the river for about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile over fairly rocky cliffs. Termination is at the point where Austin Avenue crosses the river. There are good views of the river and the cliffs on both sides of the river. Hiking boots are recommended
