If you're a film shooter and take an occasional roll of print (negative) film, and in the process, purchase a CD of the images so you can work on them at home, here is something to know:

A CD from Costco typically has about 18 meg per image.  
A CD from HEB typically has about 4.53 meg per image.

The resolution can vary from store to store and from time to time. In my opinion, you're wasting your time working on an image scan less than 15 meg.

The Computer Club's Scanners can be set for different resolutions, so be careful to set it to something you can work with.
